

Stadelman proposal to assist domestic violence victims signed into law

SPRINGFIELD — Winnebago County’s only domestic violence shelter today praised legislation passed by State Senator Steve Stadelman that helps victims escape abusive situations by giving them up to 60 days to pay initial deposits on gas, electric and water bills.

Under the law, deposits must still be paid but victims have more time to get their finances in order so they can move out. Many domestic violence victims are forced to stay in dangerous environments because they don’t have the resources to leave.

“This legislation is very beneficial for victims of domestic violence who are fleeing to safety,” said Karen Gill, vice president of operations for Remedies Renewing Lives.

“One of the biggest barriers for victims is setting all the pieces in motion, such as coming up with the money for utility deposits, to establish an independent residence.”

Gill said Stadelman’s legislation also helps shelters like Remedies, which has operated at or over capacity all summer.

“The sooner we can transition a victim to her own living arrangement,” she said. “The sooner we can offer a safe place to someone else in need.” “Giving victims additional time to get their finan-

cial affairs in order removes one of the largest hurdles for them moving out on their own. Hopefully now, these victims will be able to move to a safe place faster than ever before,” said Stadelman.

Officer recognizes motorist wanted from May 2014

LOVES PARK — On Friday, May 16, 2014, at about 11:45 p.m., a Loves Park officer observed a vehicle being operated without headlights at Lexington and Olive.

The driver drove through a yard and accelerated away from the officer. The officer terminated his attempt to stop the vehicle on N. Second St. at Spring Creek Road.

A warrant was obtained for Sergio Villegas, 27, of Rockford,

cer was dispatched to a video gaming business on N. Second

for fleeing to elude police and for driving on a suspended driver's license.

On Tuesday, Aug. 18, 2015 at around 4:50 p.m., the same offi-

cer, after receiving a call that a man had left his children in the vehicle for a long period of time, while he was inside the business.

When the officer arrived, the vehicle in question was being driven out of the business parking lot. The officer noticed that the vehicle had expired registration and stopped the vehicle at N. Second St. and Windsor Road.

The driver of the vehicle told the officer that he didn't have

identification and provided the officer a name. There was no record of a driver's license for the name. The officer recognized the driver from the 2014 pursuit.

He also knew the driver's last name, but couldn't recall his first name. In checking police records from his squad car, the officer determined the driver's true identity. Sergio Villegas was taken into custody.

Villegas was charged with driving while license suspended,

operating a vehicle with expired registration and obstructing identification.

He was also served with warrants for domestic battery out of Rockford, failure to appear in court on a suspended driver's license out of Rockford and fleeing to elude police from the 2014 Loves Park pursuit.

The charges are merely allegations and the defendant is considered innocent, unless proven guilty in a Court of Law.

- 1 pound leftover beef brisket
- 6 poached eggs

- 9 tablespoons soy sauce
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 6 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil

- 6 teaspoons dark brown sugar
- 3/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 3/4 teaspoon black pepper
- Barbecue Benedict Sauce:**
- 3 egg yolks
- 1 teaspoon vinegar
- 1 teaspoon water
- 1 cup butter, melted
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- Pinch of cayenne pepper
- 3 tablespoons of your favorite KC Masterpiece barbecue sauce

In small bowl, mix onion marinade ingredients. Pour marinade into resealable plastic bag and add onion strips. Let marinate for 30 minutes. In small bowl combine all Greek dressing ingredients. Set aside. Build charcoal fire for direct grilling. Place pita bread directly over hot coals (approximately 450°F) and cook for 1 minute on each side or until grill marks are visible. Place cucumbers, whole tomato and onion directly over hot coals (approximately 450°F) and cook, turning once, for 4 minutes or until they brown and start to soften. Remove vegetables from grill and dice. Place vegetables into medium bowl and stir in dressing. Let mixture stand for 5 minutes before adding romaine lettuce and feta cheese. Fill each pita pocket with leftover beef brisket and grilled Greek salad.

Barbecue Beef Brisket

Makes: 8-10 servings
Prep time: 30 minutes
Cook time: 5-6 hours

- 1 beef brisket flat (5-6 pounds)
- 1 tablespoon beef bouillon base
- Dry Rub
- 1 cup beef broth
- Dry Rub:**
- 1/2 tablespoon salt
- 1/2 tablespoon paprika
- 1/2 tablespoon black pepper
- 1/2 tablespoon sugar
- 3/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/4 teaspoon oregano
- 1/8 teaspoon ground coriander

Build a charcoal fire with Kingsford charcoal for indirect cooking by situating coals on only one side of grill, leaving other side void. Cover entire brisket with beef bouillon base. In small bowl, mix dry rub ingredients and coat brisket with rub. When cooker reaches 225°F, place brisket on void side of grill and close lid. 

Peanut Butter Noodle Nests with Spicy Orange Shrimp

- 1 tablespoon Sriracha sauce
- 1/4 cup orange marmalade
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon rice vinegar
- 1 tablespoon grated ginger
- 8 ounces shrimp, peeled, de-veined
- 1/4 cup onion, diced
- 1/4 cup red pepper, diced
- 2 tablespoons peanut oil
- 2 cloves minced garlic
- 1/4 cup coconut milk, plus extra
- 1/4 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1/4 cup island teriyaki sauce
- 2 teaspoons crystalized ginger
- 1 teaspoon hot pepper flakes (or to taste)
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 (12-ounce) packages ramen noodles, cooked according to package directions
- 1 cup coleslaw mix
- Peanuts and scallions, for garnish

In medium bowl, combine Sriracha, marmalade, soy sauce, vinegar and grated ginger. Stir to combine and add shrimp. Refrigerate 20 minutes.

In large skillet over medium heat, saute onion and pepper in peanut oil until tender. Add garlic and cook an additional minute. Reduce heat and add coconut milk, peanut butter, teriyaki sauce, crystalized ginger, hot pepper flakes and brown sugar. Simmer sauce 2 to 3 minutes, adding additional coconut milk as needed. Pour off 1/4 cup of sauce and add ramen noodles to remaining sauce.

In large skillet over medium heat, cook shrimp 2 to 3 minutes on each side until tender. Move shrimp to outer edge of pan and cook coleslaw mix in center just until it starts to wilt. Add wilted slaw mix to ramen sauce mixture.

Divide ramen among four plates and top with 4 or 5 shrimp. Garnish with reserved sauce, peanuts and scallions, if desired.

Spicy Peanut Butter Glazed Salmon Skewers with Warm Rice Slaw

- 1 (20-ounce) can pineapple chunks in juice, divided
- 1 1/2 pound salmon fillet, skin removed
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1 1/2 cups packaged broccoli slaw mix
- 2 cups hot cooked rice
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 1/2 cup creamy peanut butter
- 2 tablespoons Asian chili sauce (such as Sriracha)
- Juice and grated zest of 1 fresh lime
- 1/4 cup chopped salted peanuts
- Fresh lime slices, cilantro leaves and chopped peanuts, for garnish

Drain pineapple chunks, reserving juice.

Cut salmon into 1-inch cubes.

Place 1/4 cup pineapple juice into bowl with soy sauce; add salmon, tossing to coat. Let stand about 15 minutes.

Gently stir 1/4 cup pineapple juice and broccoli slaw into hot rice, blending well. Season to taste with salt and black pepper, then cover and keep warm.

Whisk peanut butter with remaining pineapple juice, chili sauce and lime juice, and zest, blending well. Set aside.

Heat oven broiler; place oven rack 6 inches from broiler element. Line broiler pan with foil and spray with nonstick spray. Thread salmon cubes and pineapple chunks onto 8 metal (or soaked bamboo) skewers, dividing equally. Place on broiler pan. Cook 2 minutes, then brush with peanut butter mixture. Repeat brushing and broiling until salmon is flaky, turning as needed to brown evenly, about 8 minutes total.

Divide warm rice mixture evenly among four serving plates; top with skewers. Sprinkle skewers lightly with chopped peanuts and serve while warm. May be garnished with additional lime slices and cilantro leaves, if desired.

Orange-Kissed Peanut Butter Bundt

- 6 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1 tablespoon orange zest
- 2 cups brown sugar, packed
- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup buttermilk

Frosting:

- 1/3 cup creamy peanut butter
- 3 tablespoons orange juice
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 1/2 cup whipped cream
- Chopped peanuts, for garnish

Heat oven to 350°F. Generously grease and flour Bundt pan. Set aside.

In large bowl mix together butter, peanut butter, orange juice and orange zest until well combined and creamy. Beat in sugar, eggs and vanilla.

Combine flour, baking soda and salt, then stir half into peanut butter mixture. Stir in half of buttermilk. Add remaining flour and buttermilk, mixing until just blended. (Don't overmix or cake will be tough.) Pour batter into prepared pan.

Bake 45-50 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Let cool in pan for about 5-10 minutes, then remove cake from pan and let cool completely.

For frosting, beat all ingredients together to pourable consistency. Pour over cake, and sprinkle with chopped peanuts.

Nutty Monkey Granola

- 2 cups old-fashioned oats
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 cup coconut flakes
- 1/3 cup chopped peanuts
- 1/4 cup sunflower seeds
- 1/4 cup pumpkin seeds
- 3 tablespoons ground flax
- 2 tablespoons chia seeds
- 1 banana
- 1 egg white
- 1/4 cup peanut butter
- 1/3 cup dried cranberries
- 1/4 cup chocolate chips

Heat oven to 375°F and line large baking sheet with parchment paper.

Combine first 8 ingredients in large mixing bowl.

Use blender to combine banana, egg white and peanut butter until smooth. Pour peanut butter mixture over oat mixture and stir until incorporated. Pour mixture in even layer on baking pan.

Bake until crisp (about 20-30 minutes), removing from oven and stirring every 10 minutes to allow granola to brown evenly and break up into smaller pieces. When granola is golden and crisp, remove from oven and stir in cranberries and chocolate chips (chocolate chips should melt a little).

Allow to cool completely before storing in air-tight container.

Peanut Butter Saltine Brittle

- 1/2 cup butter
- 3/4 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1 sleeve (4 ounces) regular saltine crackers
- 2 cups milk chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup peanut butter chips
- 1/2 cup roughly chopped, dry-roasted, salted peanuts

Heat oven to 400°F. Line 10-by-15-by-1-inch pan with aluminum foil. Spray foil with butter-flavored nonstick cooking spray; set aside.

Put butter, peanut butter and sugar in heavy-duty, 1-quart saucepan over medium heat. Stir constantly until butter and sugar are melted; bring ingredients just to a boil. Boil mixture 3 minutes, stirring frequently.

While mixture cooks, lay saltines in single layer on prepared pan.

Pour cooked mixture evenly over saltines. Place in oven and cook 5 minutes. Remove from oven and sprinkle chocolate chips over top. Let cool for 3 minutes, then spread chocolate completely over top of saltines.

Sprinkle peanut butter chips evenly over top of chocolate. Return pan to oven for 1 minute to soften chips. Pulling tines of a fork through softened chips, partially cover chocolate. Sprinkle peanuts over top and gently press peanuts down.

Let cool on rack for about 15 minutes, then place in freezer for 3 minutes. Remove from freezer and break into pieces. Store in airtight container.
