The second annual YWCA Rock County Dorothy Height Award for Diversity in the Workplace will be presented at the Second Annual YWCA Rock County Racial Justice Conference "Building Bridges to a Culture of Inclusion" on Nov. 10, at the Holiday Inn Express/Janesville Conference Center. The deadline to submit nominations for the prestigious award is Friday, Oct. 14.

The Dorothy Height Award for Diversity in the Workplace 2016 recognizes a business within Rock County that has demonstrates recognition of the strengths provided by racial diversity. The business must also exhibit a sustained commitment in the pursuit of cultural diversity, inclusion and retention in the workplace.

Leading by example, this business is transforming our diverse community into a truly inclusive environment where employees are valued for their talent and are able to reach their full potential. Community Action, Beloit, Wis., received the First Annual Dorothy Height Award at the YWCA Rock County Racial Justice Conference in 2015.

Dorothy Height, for whom is the award is named, was born

in Virginia in 1912, Dorothy Height was a civil rights and women's rights activist focused primarily on improving the circumstances of and opportunities for African-American women.

One of Height's major accomplishments at the YWCA was directing the integration of all of its centers in 1946. She also established its Center for Racial Justice in 1965, which she ran until 1977.

In 1957, Height became the president of the National Council of Negro Women. Through Ext 206. the center and the council, she became one of the lead- a mission to eliminate racism, ing figures of the Civil Rights empower women, stand up for Movement. Height worked with Martin Luther King Jr., A. Philip Randolph, Roy Wilkins, and James Farmer—sometimes Rights Movement—on different campaigns and initiatives.

numerous honors bestowed upon her include the Presidential Medal of Freedom (1994) and the Congressional Gold Medal (2004). She died on April 20, 2010, in Washington, D.C.

In association with Rabies Awareness Week, the Rock County Public Health Department, Friends of Noah and local veterinarians are sponsoring a low fee rabies vaccination clinic for cats and dogs at the Rock County Fairgrounds on Saturday. Sept. 24 from 1 to 4 pm.

People with unvaccinated cats and dogs are invited to attend. The fee is \$10, cash only. Dogs must be on leashes and cats confined to carriers.

A limited number of leashes and carriers will be available. Animal owners are responsible for keeping their pets under control. Vaccinations are good for one year.

If an owner can provide proper documentation of a prior rabies vaccination, their dog or cat can receive a threeyear vaccination. Animal health care will be limited to the rabies vaccination.

The rabies clinic augments good pet care. Every pet owner should have a relationship with a veterinarian to provide basic health care for their pet. If owners are currently working with a local veterinarian for the pet care, they are encouraged to continue that relationship for rabies vaccination and other animal health care.

"Rabies can threaten all members of the family, including pets," said veterinarian Dr. Steven Servantez. "When untreated, rabies in humans is almost always fatal. However, it is also 100% preventable.

This underscores the critical need for community members to take the appropriate steps to prevent and control rabies.'

The village plans to hire a company to remove asbestos from the former J.C. Penney Outlet building it owns at the south end of the Machesney Towne Center, 8702 N. Second St.

Public Works Supt. Chad Hunter explained that before the village purchased the building in 2015, a pre-sale inspection found asbestos beneath some of the flooring in the main sales and office areas.

During the closing, he said the village was able to negotiate a credit of \$122,000 to remove the mastic that

was identified with the asbestos mate-

The village plans to use part of the credit to hire a contractor to remove the asbestos "to give the space a clean bill of health and make it more desirable to buyers," he said.

Staff received bids from three licensed asbestos contractors as follows: Husar Abatement, Ltd., \$49,500; Balestrieri Group, \$87,512; and Tropical Environmental Inc., \$122,250.

Acting on staff's recommendation the administration and finance committee voted Sept. 6 to approve a resolution that accepts the low bid submitted by Husar Abatement. The full require additional information of the village board is expected to act on the recommendation at Monday night's meeting.

Meanwhile, the search is continuing for retail tenants to occupy the front 40,000 square feet of the 110,000-square-foot building.

"We've been showing the building and are hopeful we'll have occupants lined up soon," James Richter II, community development director, said.

Before receiving the asbestos credit, the village was on target to buy the building for 900,000. The asking price was \$1.2 million. The 5-2 vote in favor of the purchase came Jan. 2, 2015, with trustees James Kidd and Aaron Wilson dissenting.

Since acquisition the village's public works department has relocated from village hall to 10,000 square feet in the old Penney's building. Cost of remodeling was \$3,500.

In addition, the village is working on a text amendment to its zoning ordinance to make massage parlors a special use, only allowable in the commercial general district.

First stop for the proposal was the planning and zoning commission. After discussion, commissioner laid the issue over to their Sept. 25 meeting.

As proposed, the amendment would

applicant at the time request is submitted. The business also would have to meet required criteria as generally is the case with special use requests.

There was a motion to approve the amendment, with a second, at the commission's Aug. 22 meeting. But action was delayed after:

* Commissioners expressed concern about Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, known better as HIPAA, and the proposed requirement that massage establishments keep a log of client information.

HIPAA is a federal law that gives people rights over their health information. It sets rules and limits on who can look at and receive that information.

There was a lot of conversation about separating the "massage parlors" the village is seeking to regulate from massage therapists who are health and wellness related. Some were concerned the regulations eventually could impact chiropractors and physical therapists.

Staff explained the regulations would apply only to a business that just offers massages that are not of a medical nature. Also, they would not impact massages that are accessory to a hair salon or similar business.

Currently, there are no such businesses in Machesney Park.

Roast Turkey with Gravy

- whole uncooked turkey
- tablespoons olive oil teaspoons Angostura Aromatic Bitters, divided
- freshly ground pepper 1/2 yellow onion, cut into 4-5 pieces
- large cloves garlic, peeled

Place turkey on rack in pan. Cover and roast as directed for size of turkey. Internal

temperature when done should be 165 F. While turkey roasts, stir together flour, brandy and remaining bitters; stir until mixture is smooth and no longer lumpy. Whisk in chicken broth and set aside.

When turkey is done, remove from pan to serving platter; cover with foil to keep warm. Remove onion and garlic from pan; discard. Tilt pan toward one end and skim excess fat from top of pan juices. Place pan on stovetop over medium-high heat. With wire whisk, add broth mixture and stir constantly, scraping browned bits from bottom of pan. Continue to stir until gravy has thickened. Season with salt, to taste. Serve with sliced turkey.

Note: For thicker gravy, add 1 tablespoon flour to 1/4 cup water; stir until smooth. Stir 1-2 tablespoons hot gravy into mixture then whisk into roasting pan. Continue stirring until gravy thickens more.

Cranberry-Orange Pecan Bread

- 1 rounded cup fresh or frozen cranberries (about 4 1/2 ounces)
- 2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour
- cup sugar teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 3/4 cup toasted pecans or walnuts, coarsely chopped large egg
- cup low-fat buttermilk
- tablespoons butter, melted
- tablespoons orange zest cup orange juice
- teaspoons Angostura Orange
- **Bitters** 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

Heat oven to 350 F. Lightly grease 9-by-5-inch loaf pan.

If using frozen cranberries, spread berries out on cutting board and let rest for 10 minutes. Cut large cranberries

In large bowl, combine flour with sugar, baking powder, salt, baking soda, nuts and egg; blend thoroughly with whisk. Stir in cranberries.

In small bowl, whisk together buttermilk, butter, orange zest, orange juice, bitters and vanilla extract. Add to dry ingredients and stir gently until fully moistened; do not over mix. Spoon batter into pan and smooth out top.

Bake 50 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Let rest in pan 10 minutes then turn out onto wire rack to cool completely for at least 1 hour before slicing.

Island Eggnog

- 6 eggs, beaten
- teaspoons grated lime zest cans (14 ounces) sweetened
- condensed milk cups canned evaporated milk
- cups Angostura 7 Year Rum
- ounce Angostura Aromatic Bitters
- pinch freshly grated nutmeg or cinnamon

In large bowl, beat eggs and lime zest using electric mixer until light and fluffy. Gradually pour in condensed milk while continuing to mix then pour in evaporated milk.

Upon arrival, Rockford Fire Department was on scene and advised officers a deceased female had been located. The victim appeared to be suffering from a gunshot wound.



All charges are merely allegations and parties are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty in a court of law.




