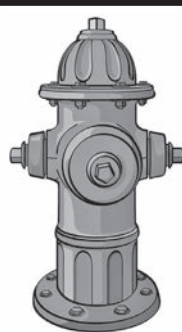

State Police announce the use of roadside safety checks

Illinois State Police (ISP) District 16, Commander, Captain Mark Karczewski, announces the ISP will conduct Roadside Safety Checks (RSCs) in Winnebago County during May.

The use of RSCs combine a strong sense of public awareness and enforcement in order to save lives of the motoring public.

The ISP has zero tolerance for impaired driving in Illinois. Officers

working the detail will be watchful for drivers who are operating vehicles in an unsafe manner, driving with a suspended or revoked driver's license, transporting open alcoholic beverages, and most importantly:

- Driving Under the Influence (DUI);
- Safety Belt and Child Restraint use;
- Speeding;
- Distracted Driving; and,
- All Illinois Vehicle Code and Criminal Violations.

Alcohol and drug impairment is a factor in more than 30 percent of all fatal motor vehicle crashes in Illinois, and throughout the U.S., nearly 10,000 people die each year due to alcohol-impaired driving. RSCs are designed to keep our roads safe by taking dangerous DUI offenders off the road. This project is funded through the Illinois Department of Transportation.

State Police announce special traffic enforcement patrols

Illinois State Police District 16 Commander, Captain Mark Karczewski, announced last week that officers will conduct special Traffic Enforcement Patrols (sTEP) between May 19-29 in Winnebago and JoDaviess Counties.

District 16 Troopers will concentrate on speeding, failure to use occupant restraints, and other driving offenses as part of their enforcement efforts. The sTEP program involves a combination of increased enforcement and public information designed to raise public awareness and compliance to all traffic laws. Speeding is a contributing factor in 31 percent of all fatal crashes nationwide. In Illinois, speed-related crashes account for over 40 percent of all traffic fatalities.

Safety Belt Enforcement Zones may also be used during the sTEP program.

Troopers will enforce the primary safety belt law to ensure drivers and all of their passengers are buckled up.

Every hour someone dies in America simply because they are not wearing their safety belt. Statistics show that half

of all people killed in traffic crashes are not properly buckled up. You can save your life by driving safely and simply buckling up. This project is funded by the Illinois Department of Transportation, Division of Traffic Safety.

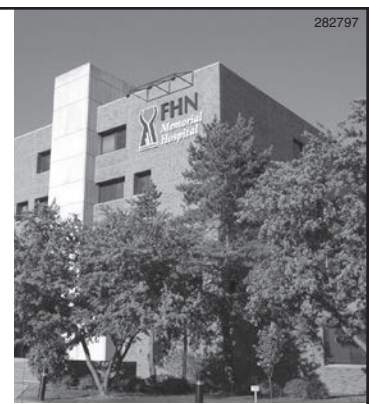

Money available to Illinois Public School Teachers

The Illinois Retired Teachers Association Foundation (IRTAF) is making \$36,500 in grant money available statewide to individual public school classroom teachers (PK-12) for the 2017-18 school year. These grants are designed for special projects the teachers might not be able to have funded through the normal budgetary process. In this time of short budgets, state shortfalls and economic and budgetary insecurity for public schools, these grants can be very helpful.

"These grants won't only assist teachers doing their work, but ultimately students will benefit as well," Dave Davison, president of the Illinois Retired Teachers Association said. "Our goal and hope is that our state's teachers have the tools and resources available to inspire and empower students. With these grants, we believe better instruction will be delivered and more students will be engaged as learners."

"It's great to know that an organi-

zation like the IRTAF supports teachers when dollars for education are so tight," Jean Hoff, an IRTA member from Ogle-Lee Retired Teachers Association said. "Grants like these have a ripple effect, from the teacher to the student, through the school, through the community and then ultimately through the state."

To apply, download, complete, and submit the application online by visiting www.irtaonline.org. The application can be found in the IRTA Foundation section. All applications must be submitted by June 1, 2017. A special committee will select the recipients of the grants. Grant awards will be presented in the fall.

"Far too often teachers spend money out of their own pocket to supplement classroom and learning experiences," Davison concluded. "Founded by teachers, the IRTAF prides itself not only by assisting retired teachers now living in poverty but the great ideas and visions teachers have for their stu-

dents but are limited by lack of funds."

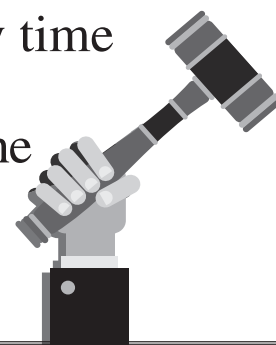
