Rockton Lions Club Old Settlers Days offering family fun

Old Settlers Days is returning in its 18th year of bringing family fun to the Stateline. The four-day festival starts on June 15 and runs until June 18 at Settlers Park in Rockton.

A four day admission passes costs \$6 in advance or \$10 at each starting June 15. Main stage concert tickets require an additional ticket. Children under 12 do not require a four day pass. Main Stage concert tickets are \$20 in advance and \$25 if purchased at the door. Weekend wrist bands may be purchased at a special rate of \$85. This special saves \$45 from at the gate pricing which includes: Admission to the festival grounds all four days, the carnival, food court plus all of the concerts on both the main and festival stages. Tickets must be redeemed for wristbands which must be worn all weekend.

Start the OSD event out by giving the gift of life from 1 to 8 p.m. at the Greater Rockton Centre on the festivals opening day of June 15. Those who give blood will receive a free OSD admission pass. Those who bring a pair of used eyeglasses to be recycled will receive a second free pass.

Gates to OSD fun will open to loads of fun. Get ready to take a spin on carnival rides and play games at a midway by Skinner's Amusements. Different food booths will cater to every taste and budget.

Start Saturday off by entering the OSD parade or come as a spectator. Various vendors will have items to purchase.

A fun run to benefit the Carrie Lynn Center has added a second option catering to those who may be unable to run or walk in the 5K. The option of helping from your couch has been added with a Zero-K. All participants also receive an OSD5K shirt, festival pass and admission to the post run breakfast. Those who opt to join in the fun on race day can line up with participants who are walking and finish the race at the starting line.

Those who are up for a competitive challenge will want to be part of the fun run. The course is USATF Certified. The 5K is slated for June 18. Runners start at 8 a.m. Walkers leave 10 minutes after. Following check in, and packet pickups, an opening ceremony consists of a colors presentation and singing of our National Anthem. The course begins at the Hononegah High School south parking lot. Registration fees for adults are \$30, and children 12 and under, \$20. Late registration fees after June 1 are \$40. Mail in registration may be done online at RunSignUp.com, or can be mailed in to Rockton PD, Sgt. Dean Camacho, and 110 East Main Street, Rockton, IL. 61072. Race questions may be directed to Michelle Masters at info@osd5k.com, or call 815-200-1096. All participants get cool swag items such as the 2015 OSD Tech-shirt, OSD four day festival pass if over 12 years of age, and OSD 5K water bottle, free admission to the Rockton Volunteer Associa-

tion pancake breakfast, plus other awesome goodies!

Results will be tallied by a professional electronic bib chip timing method. Age divisions run eight and under to ages up to over 70. Best overall male and female, and top three finishers in each age group earn an OSD 5K medal, and a meet and greet pass for the main performer that evening. The top three finishers per division will be awarded per placement.

Country music fans are in luck as stars Trace Adkins and Jake Owen are two well-known headliners performing on the OSD Main State. Four nights will feature these country stars along with

Granger Smith -featuring Earl Dibbles Jr., and Tyler Farr. The Cadillac Three, Smithfield, Jackie Lee, Walker McGuire and Kassi Ashton will warm up the crowds.

Different genres of musical entertainment will be heard on the Festival stage. Listen to sounds of Dirt Road Rebelz, Audio Drive, Hip Pocket, Jamie Campbell and the Redneck Romeos, Brutal Wedgie, Kevin Burns- Good Vibrations, Dirty Fishnet Stockings, and Cole Brandt. Family fun comes in the form of magic performed by the very talented Johnny Silver.

With road construction underway the Old Settlers Days com-

mittee recommends using different routes to come into Rockton such as Highway 2. Thanks to a partnership between the Rockton Lions Club, Chemtool and Laidlaw Bus Company shuttle busses will be available to ride over to festival grounds from the Chemtool parking lot.

An informational booth, a beer tent, raffle tickets, and a Lions Den VIP tent add extra fun options.

A full list of events and activity schedules can be located on the Rockton Lions Club Old Settlers Days website. Also included are details on the Carrie Lynn Center benefit race and the parade for

those who would like to participate.

Rounding out the festival fireworks will fill the sky with colorful splendor on Sunday evening; weather permitting.

Profits of the OSD festival will be given back to the community through various donations. Organizations assisted by the Rockton Lions Club include but are not limited to: The Center for Sight and Hearing, Boy Scout Troop#619, Talcott Library, and the Old Stone Church Food Pantry. Money that was raised from last year's OSD festival went toward building a new shelter house at the Rockton Athletic Fields.

Life is filled with bad days, good days

It was a day like all others and a day like no other. As was the day before, and the day after. As are all days. Just days. But often so much more.

A friend mentioned it was her wedding anniversary. She was in a celebratory mood, and rightly so. I asked her the date, because I wasn't sure, and when she told me I realized it was an anniversary for me as well. Except mine was a sorrowful milestone.

I felt a cloud descend and a pit grow in my stomach. I'd forgotten, or at the least failed to remember. Guilt crept in like a spider, weaving its web in an ever-tightening snare. I should have remembered. I should have felt bad because the day – for me – had been marked forevermore as marred and damaged.

Dates take on personal meaning for us. But they can be widespread as well. On the day in question, thousands – millions even – experienced shock and sadness at the unexpected death of a pop icon. A cloud fell over the already descending sadness of my day as the country mourned together.

At the same instant, babies were born, creating joy in one hospital room, while just down the hall a family said its goodbyes to a sick father or mother or spouse.

I mulled over the dichotomy. What do we make of each day? How does our approach affect the type of day we have? Why does the date on the calendar make any day good or bad?

It doesn't. Or at least it doesn't have to. We can be dictated by our circum-

stance – and often are – but I believe we can break free and see and experience the world through a lens of our own choosing.

Just because I had an extremely sorrowful, terribly awful thing happen to me on a certain date doesn't banish that date to the regions of horribleness forever. If that were the case, and I was able to remember every distressing thing that has ever happened to me, ev-

ery day would probably be a bad, sad, mad, I-don't-want-to-get-out-of-bed kind of day.

That wouldn't be any fun.

Initially, I felt guilty about not remembering I was "supposed" to be having a bad day because somehow that made my loss less significant. Then I realized that line of thinking was pretty dumb. Feeling bad because I thought I was supposed to feel bad was akin to needlessly throwing the day away. It was giving power to the negativity and guilt and spiders.

Nothing I can do now can have any impact on the loss I experienced seven years ago. It is real every day. And I still feel sorrow sometimes – like now, writing about it. But I don't have to mark a date on the calendar and set it aside

for mourning. The day doesn't have to be labeled as a loss for the rest of my eternity.

Life is hard enough as it is without us putting up our own roadblocks. Which we all do – all too often.

On the day in question, I forgot my grief, but I didn't forget my loss. I think that means I am moving on. In slow steps the joy and happiness return. And they can be just as real as grief. More real, even – when you've earned them.

Ziplining: The next adventure for folks in their 70s

Last year, Mother's Day 2016, my mom jumped out of a perfectly good airplane. It all started the year before when my son Andrew wanted to go skydiving for his 21st birthday. He and I were both surprised when he told his grandparents about his upcoming adventure-- they didn't freak out as expected. Instead they said, "We might like to try that."

That launched Andrew's birthday jump to include Grandpa, age 75, and me and my Prince (age 50) to mark milestone years with a crazy daring day. Andrew's buddy Casey joined in as did my then-assistant Dreamboat Annie. My mom decided she would stay on the ground.

I wrote about our experience back then. You can find it in my blog and on Facebook. (Cure for constipation? Skydiving.) In a nutshell, they all enjoyed it. Me? No way do I ever need to jump out of a plane again or be in the plane watching said loved ones take the plunge out the door into the great wide open. It makes me dizzy now even imagining it.

Anyway, my mom and my sister watched that day and decided they wanted to try it. So on Mom's Day last year the two of them along with both my sons (firstborn now home from Arizona) went skydiving. They all loved it.

So for this most recent Mother's Day, how do we top that? We don't. Jumping out of a plane is a singularly unique experience. Nothing compares. Roller coasters? No. Hang gliding? No. Hot air balloon? No. Racking my brain for a gift idea, I wanted to do some kind of experience that would include the whole family. The answer? Zip lining.

I booked my mom and her offspring a 2-hour adventure course. Ten of us spent the afternoon zip-

ping above the trees. It was not as wild as free falling from a plane, but still has a bit of a thrill factor. And everyone can participate. My parents and their brood had a few laughs as we finagled our harnesses, helmets, and hearts. Stepping off the first platform (and the last, it's a really high one) ain't for sissies.

When I tell people how we spent the afternoon, many are amazed that

my 74-year-old mom and 77-year-old dad are able to do such stuff. The tour required plenty of walking including a suspension bridge that truly was a challenge and seven flights of stairs to a 65-foot tower.






