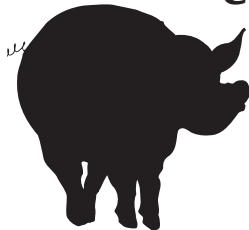

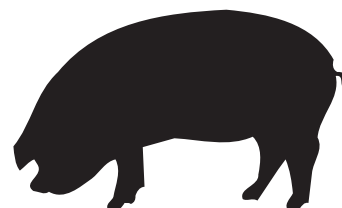

Man sentenced for attempted first degree murder

Winnebago County State's Attorney Joe Bruscato announces that Demetrius Deon Love, 24, pled guilty to Attempt First Degree Murder in front of the Honorable Judge Randy Wilt.

On June 5, 2016, Rockford Police responded to 1107 Furman St. for a shots fired call. Officers found the victim, Rashawn Smith, suffering from a gunshot wound to the eye. Smith survived, and provided a written statement indicating that the person who shot him was Demetrius Love. The following investigation led police to the gun Love used in the crime.

Attempt First Degree Murder is a Class X Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-30 years in the Illinois Dept. of Corrections followed by three years of Mandatory Supervised Release.

Love is scheduled to be sentenced at 3 p.m. on Oct. 30, by the Honorable Judge Randy Wilt.
