

DeCastris announces run for Illinois House's 67th District

Longtime community volunteer and activist Valeri DeCastris is a candidate for the 67th Illinois House District in the March 20, 2018 Democratic primary.

Her priorities are bringing more tax dollars back to Rockford from Springfield, economic development, job creation, training and retention, strong local constituent service, crime and public health, and civil rights.

Valeri is a Rockford native with experience working as a research associate for the Illinois General Assembly, spending nine years in Springfield advising the Legislature and working with state and federal agencies.

She was also an environmental scientist and public health advisor with the State of Illinois and at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale, where she managed research laboratories.

Currently, she is a science consultant and small business owner. She has been married to David Beccue for 19 years and they live in her family's ancestral home on Cunningham Street in south Rockford, where her family has lived for five generations.

Valeri returned to her hometown of Rockford in 1995 and has helped rebuild the south, west and downtown areas of Rockford. She founded the Ethnic Village Neighborhood Association 23 years ago and serves as its president.

Valeri has led and spearheaded several successful beautification and cultural projects in Rockford and has been an active participant in the revitalization of Rockford.

She has brought tens of thousands of dollars in state and foundation grants to the Ethnic Village Neighborhood and provided input to and supported millions of dollars in infrastructure improvements there.

Her notable civic volunteer achievements are:

Served for 19 years on Citizens Utility Board (CUB) - Illinois' largest consumer advocacy group

Established Immigrants Park at Winnebago and Cunningham Streets

Installed banners, flower baskets and flower planters on and near the Winnebago Street bridge

Had lighting upgraded and decorative streetlights installed in Ethnic Village Neighborhood

Initiated the Memory Garden of bronze statues of schoolchildren at St. Anthony Church

Involved in the planning of the South Main Street improvements and Morgan Street bridge

Board member of Greater Rockford Italian American Association (GRIAA) - Festa Italiana

First executive director of Southwest Ideas for Today and Tomorrow (SWITTT) planning group

Developed Rockford's Sister City with Ferentino, Italy and coordinated City Council ceremony

Participated in Immigration History Exhibit at Midway Village Museum (it's largest exhibit)

Helped create Energy Division within City of Carbondale, Ill. and solar energy center

Valeri has served on the boards of many Illinois non-profit organizations. She is a State appointee to the Illinois Human Rights Authority and was a Mayoral Appointee to the Rockford Brownfields Advisory Task Force (to clean up and reuse contaminated industrial and commercial properties) and the Carbondale Energy Futures Task Force, which made permanent energy policy for the City of Carbondale, Ill.

RoRo Expo history dates back to 1992

In 1992, under a different name and smaller in size, the early beginnings of RoRo Expo began. The name "RoRo" came to be in 1996, as a spinoff of BOCO, which stands for the Boone County Expo.

The original idea for RoRo was to have an opportunity once a year for local area businesses, that did not have a storefront, to showcase themselves to the public. The main founders of the event were American Family Insurance, Beloit Daily News, The Rockton Herald along with numerous realtors, local banks and small businesses.

The first expo was held in the main gymnasium of Hononegah High School. Approximately 45 booths displayed their business while the metal gym was used for non-profit organizations and food vendors.

In 1996, the RoRo Expo, with the guidance of Miss Pennycook, was adopted by the Roscoe Area and Rockton Chambers of Commerce with a new look and feel. These two "Chamber Neighbors" worked together for one purpose, to showcase our community to you. In 2002, the RoRo Expo was able to enlarge to over 150 vendors under one roof. This enlarged event was due to the newly constructed Hononegah Community High School Athletic Dome. It was at this time that all food vendors, area businesses and non-profit organizations could combine in one location along with the entertainment, demonstrations and the new kidz corner.

In 2010, the idea of "giving back" to one of our own, became a new focus along with offering free services to the public. Cotton candy sales, hair cuts, chili cook-off contests and more, were held to help raise funds for the Goldie B Floberg Center of Rockton.

The free services that were also added for our visitors were things like children's car seat checks, blood pressure screenings, eye & hearing exams, blood drive and children's DNA/ID information just to name a few.

In 2012, we expanded the "Free Services" at RoRo Expo by enlarging the kidz corner, "giving back" to the local

food pantry and offered four clinics through out the weekend event that visitors could partake in.

This year there will be more new vendors that will have information for you about their company and old friendly faces of those you already do business with. The basic idea of RoRo still exists today, with the main focus on showcasing our stateline community to you.

This past 2017 Expo, more than 100 area businesses were on hand to talk with you and over 7,500 people came to visit, keeping this, "The Stateline's Premier Exhibitor Event."

Asparagus Tart

- 1 sheet frozen puff pastry, thawed
- 2 cups Jarlsberg Cheese, shredded
- 1 pound asparagus
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 tablespoon fresh thyme leaves
- salt
- pepper

Heat oven to 400 F. Prepare baking sheet with parchment paper.

Roll out puff pastry into 16-by-10-inch rectangle; trim uneven edges. Place on baking sheet. Using knife, lightly score pastry dough 1 inch from edges. Using fork, pierce dough inside markings at 1/2-inch intervals. Bake until golden, about 15 minutes.

Remove pastry shell from oven and sprinkle with shredded cheese. Trim bottoms of asparagus spears to fit crosswise inside pastry shell; arrange in single layer over cheese, alternating ends and tips. Brush with oil, sprinkle with thyme leaves and season with salt and pepper. Bake until spears are tender, about 20 minutes.

Corn Muffins

Corn Muffins

- 3/4 cup milk
- 2 eggs
- 1/4 cup plain flour
- 1 1/4 cups cornmeal
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 4 tablespoons softened butter
- 1/2 cup Jarlsberg Cheese, plus additional cured ham, thinly sliced (optional)

Nut Pesto:

- 5 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 pack fresh, flat-leaf parsley
- 1 garlic clove
- 1/2 cup walnuts
- 1/4 cup cashews
- salt
- pepper

Heat oven to 375 F. Whisk together milk and eggs.

In separate bowl, mix flour, cornmeal, sugar, baking powder and butter. Add milk-egg mixture and stir. Spoon mixture into muffin cases.

Cut cheese into cubes and press down into mixture. Bake in center of oven about 15 minutes.

To make Nut Pesto: In blender or using hand blender, combine olive oil, parsley, garlic, walnuts, cashews, salt and pepper. Pulse or blend until coarsely chopped.

Serve corn muffins with additional cheese, Nut Pesto and thin slices of cured ham, if desired.

Notes: If possible, use stiff paper cups, so muffins stand up better. Cornbread can also be baked in large, round baking pan, about 20 centimeters in diameter; adjust baking time as needed until done.

Festive Salmon Cake

- 2 cans (16 ounces each) red salmon or tuna, drained and flaked
- 1 package (10 ounces) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and well drained
- 2 1/2 cups shredded Jarlsberg Cheese, divided
- 1 cup fresh bread crumbs
- 2 lightly beaten eggs
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1/2 cup minced onion
- 1/2 cup parsley
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 package (16 ounces) frozen mixed vegetables, cooked and drained or 2 cups fresh, chopped mixed vegetables, steamed

Heat oven to 350 F.

In large bowl, combine canned fish, spinach, 1 1/2 cups cheese, bread crumbs, eggs and lemon juice; blend well. In skillet, saute onion and parsley in olive oil until onion is translucent. Add to fish mixture. Spread mixture into well-oiled 8-inch springform pan and bake 30 minutes. Top with remaining cheese.

To serve, remove from pan. Place on serving platter or low pedestal and arrange mixed vegetables on top.

Puff Pastry Swirls

Puff Pastry Swirls

- 4 ready-rolled puff pastry sheets
- 1 1/4 cups grated Jarlsberg Cheese
- 2 sprigs fresh rosemary, chopped
- pepper

Heat oven to 375 F.

On lightly floured work surface using rolling pin, roll out pastry sheets into rectangles about 20-by-10 centimeters each. Mix cheese, rosemary and pepper. Spread mixture over puff pastry sheets.

Roll up each pastry rectangle from short end. Press edges firmly together to seal roll. Slice each roll into 3-centimeter thick slices. Place face-down on baking sheet and bake about 15-20 minutes.

Note: To allow pastry swirls to rise more, don’t roll out pastry with rolling pin.
