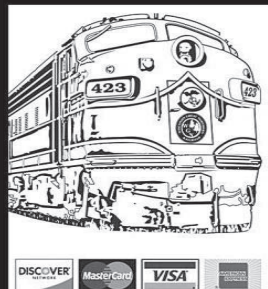

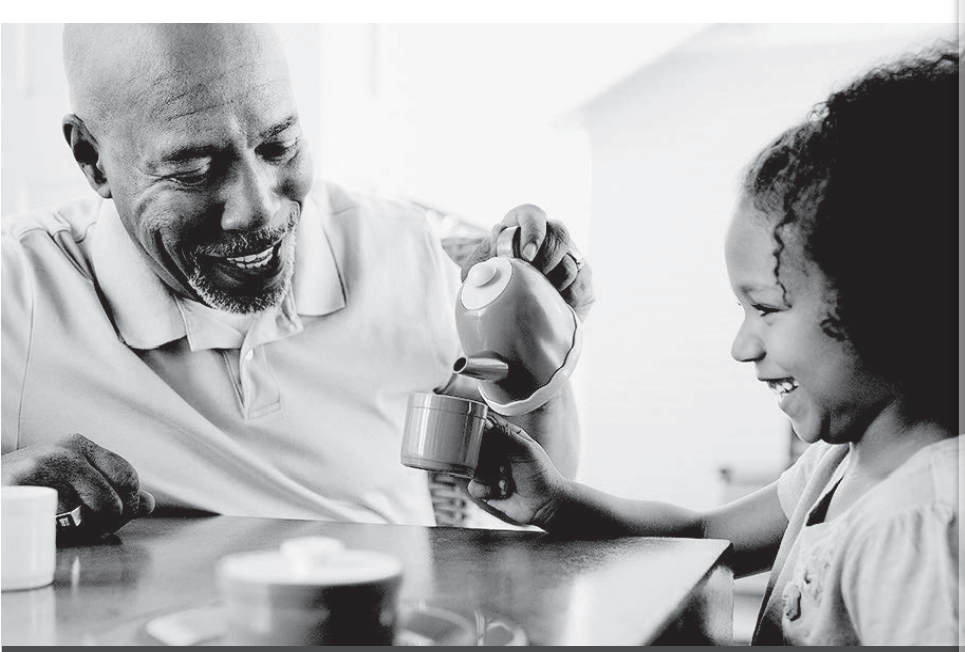
later my arm turned to all out intense pain that hasn't really let up much since then.

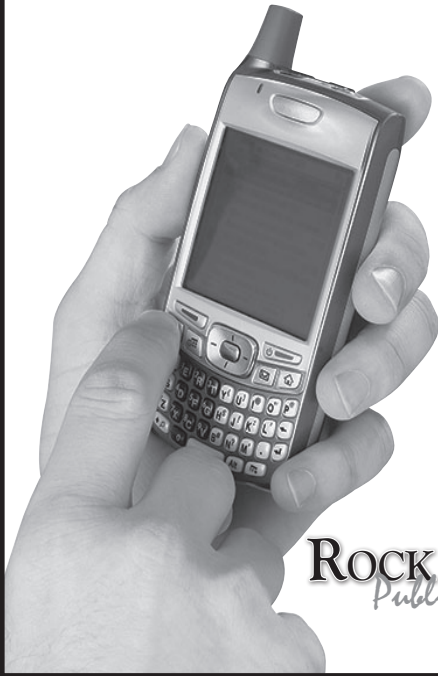
