Life with a toddler

"Oh, oh!" is her go-to phrase for any number of circumstances: when her freezie drips on the floor, when she can't open a door or cupboard, when her mom won't let her eat a crayon, when grandpa drops his phone, and so on. Just about any situation can (and does) illicit an "Oh, oh!"

She loves looking out the window at Outside. The only thing better than looking at Outside is going there. If she hears the word "outside" or the word "park" she grabs her shoes and heads to the door – ready to go.

She is a daredevil, especially at the park, where no slide is too



big or too fast. She plunges down the steepest incline with abandon. Gleeful, giggling and asking for "more."

She loves crawling into cubbylike spaces – the smaller the better. She discovered she could fit into the cupboard and thought this was the best hiding spot. It was on the windowsill. Why we didn't look there earlier, I don't know.

After the big remote mystery was solved some of us were ready for some fun at the park. With the mere mention of the "P" word she grabbed her shoes and headed for the door. The slides were waiting.

In my opinion **Idleness - Rest and reduce stress**

Rest is not idleness, and to lie sometimes on the grass under the trees on a summer's day, listening to the murmur of water, or watching the clouds float across the blue sky, is by no means waste of time. ~John Lubbock, "Recreation," The Use of Life, 1894

One thing I'm better at in this phase of life is resting. Taking a break. And not feeling guilty. I used to think I must always be doing something. If not working, then doing household tasks or tending to someone or something.

Now, I savor quiet time, alone and with my Prince Charming.

One of the surprising joys of this house is that it came with a small pool, an 18-foot-round circle of heaven built into the deck. It's only four feet deep, but endlessly relaxing.

We float and look up at the sky and talk and hold hands and listen to music and watch the herons fly over and are mesmerized by the shapeshifting clouds.

It never would have occurred to me that two 50-somethings would enjoy a little pool so much but now we know that if we ever move from here, we will make sure we have a little pool.

Lying on the grass, or lying in a pool, is important for peace of mind. Taking a breather is by no means

a waste of time. It makes you more energized in the long run.

Why must we give rest a bad rap? It bums me out that the first definition of idleness is laziness, so we see being idle as a bad thing. (Oh, how we label everything good or bad!) The second definition is lack of action or activity, but isn't that what we need sometimes?

When we are resting, we are doing something. Lying on the beach is doing something. Floating in a pool is an action. Sunbathing counts as activity in my book. So does forest bathing. And sky bathing.

If I must defend my action/ inaction: time in my little pool is full of activity. We have waterproof cards and a floating table and chairs where we play rummy. We have great conversation. We have friends and family over. I practice my handstands. I nap.

And, of course, I don't need to defend.

I'm simply encouraging you to partake of a little rest this month. And next. And the next....

If you don't have a backyard that is peaceful and private, go find a park or green space. Take a blanket or chair and nothing else. Just go sit. Watch the sky.

Thirty minutes of "idleness" will refresh you. When your car is idling, it's running but not moving. It's still working. We can still be "on" and do not need to be on the move all the time.

The best stress buster of summer costs nothing, adds no calories, and can be done anywhere: watching the clouds float across the blue sky.


