





Weekly connection

The strength to win the gold ball

I remember moving into the Black Hawk School District in southwest, Wisconsin when I was just starting the fifth grade. My family had finally found a dairy farm of our own to buy and we quickly made the move from Indiana to Wisconsin. It only took a couple of weeks to realize that football was a big deal at my new school. We played at every recess and noon hour that we could. When the recess lady took our football away saying that we were too rough, we used a little round kickball that we could grip in one hand and kept right on playing. When it was rainy and we had to stay inside, we folded up a sheet of paper into a little triangle and played that football game on tables in the indoor recess room. You know that game where one clips the paper triangle "football" with your finger to make it balance on the edge of the table without falling off for a touchdown. Then one would tip it on edge and clip it through your opponent's "uprights" for the extra point. It was great having the football coach as your gym teacher too, because during gym class we got to have a long flag football unit as well. He kept track of our win/ loss records and we even had a championship game at the end of

Football was king at Black Hawk and so was Coach Murphy. Dennis Murphy came to Black Hawk as a "wet behind the ears" young man right out of UW Platteville. He told me he passed up a job to teach agriculture at another school because he wanted to coach football.

The Black Hawk position opened up late that year after a couple weeks of practice had already begun in the fall of 1967. After he was hired, the administrator pointed to the field and said, "that's your team." Coach Murphy hit the ground running and the rest is history. His passion for football and kids brought a love for the sport to this community that never left. He kept coaching the football and baseball teams all the way up until 2004 when he handed over the reins to one of his former players, quarterback Cory Milz

Coach Murphy always wanted his quarterback to be a senior. He loved the leadership a senior QB brought to the team, so he groomed us. When I was a freshman, I went to the QB meetings in the summer with the other three QB upper classmen. Sure enough my senior year I had the job, Warrior quarterback. We were coming off an undefeated season my junior year and we had lost almost everyone and the kitchen sink from that team. Somehow, we still managed, strictly on tradition I believe, to win seven of our first eight games and there we were playing for the conference championship in our last game. I don't know how we did it, except that we all had such a passion for the

game, from our "Warrior tradition". Later I was able to spend six years coaching alongside Dennis Murphy before moving on to coach 27 years of football in Clinton, Wisconsin. I never forgot my roots.

It was such a joy to watch the Black Hawk and Warren teams come together this year as one big Warrior nation. The Warren kids made huge contributions to be sure and now we celebrate with them the great tradition of Warrior Football. Yes, the QB was a senior this year and he was from Warren. He did a marvelous job of leading the team and executing a new offense all year long including throwing a touchdown pass which accounted for the only score in last week's Division 7 Wisconsin State Championship victory. I grew up just a stone's throw from Warren and my brother-in-law has taught PE there for years as well, so it's just great to experience this with them.

One of the QB's I was able to coach when I was at Black Hawk years ago was Coach Cory Milz. What a job he has done. Over the last 15 years, he has taken the program to the next level and will be greatly missed as he has decided to retire from coaching. I'm sure the program won't miss a beat as the tradition moves on. Thanks Coach Murphy and Coach Milz for all your dedication to discipline and sportsmanship over the years.

I love I Corinthians 9:24 which reads; do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way as to take the prize. Congratulations Warriors on your run for the gold. We hope and pray you use this experience to become leaders and men of God who know where your strength and the gift of life comes from.


