

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse expiration dates for driver's licenses White is announcing Driver Services facilities statewide will be closed to the public for in person transactions effective Tuesday, Nov. 17 and will reopen on Monday, Dec. 7, 2020, due to the worsening COVID-19 pandemic. White is encouraging the public to take advantage of online services.

"After careful consideration, we have decided to close all Driver Services facilities until Dec. 7, 2020, due to the worsening COVID-19 pandemic," said White. We have extended expiration dates to assist people during this difficult time. I am also encouraging customers to consider using online services which are available for many office transactions.'

As White noted, many transactions with the Secretary of State's office may be conducted online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com, some of which
