Weekly connection History's greatest moment

I called my message on Easter Sunday, "The Resurrection - History's greatest moment." Because quite honestly it was.


The resurrection of Jesus Christ is so real that for the past 2,000 years the lives of millions and millions, maybe billions have been forever changed and the best is yet to come for every believer.

One of my favorite authors is Lee Strobel. He was a staunch atheist giving all his effort and study to prove that there is no God and that the



resurrection of Jesus was nothing more than a fairy tale. While studying to prove there is no God or

resurrection, Lee Strobel ended up being thoroughly convinced that the opposite was true.



Lee Strobel gives us four basic proofs of the resurrection to consider. First of all, in order for

there to be a resurrection we must know that JESUS WAS DEAD Did Jesus die on the cross? Was he dead? Virtually every scholar on planet Earth concedes that Jesus was dead

after the crucifixion.

We have no record of anyone, anywhere, ever surviving a full Roman crucifixion. Even the Journal of the American Medical Association published a peer reviewed scientific medical study of the evidence for the death of Jesus and said, "Clearly the weight of the evidence indicates that Jesus was dead even before the spear wound was inflicted by the Roman guard."

Even the atheist New Testament scholar Gerd

Lüdeman says, "Historically it's indisputable that Jesus was dead." So, Jesus was dead.

I remember when I was at State University taking a philosophy class years ago, my professor, who didn't believe in any miracles in the Bible whatsoever, told the class that it is very likely that Jesus was not dead on the cross but that when He was taken down from the cross and laid in the tomb, the cool temperatures of the tomb helped to revive Him.

His disciples then overpowered the Roman guards, rolled a huge twothousand-pound stone away from the opening of the tomb and took Jesus for the medical help He needed to survive.

Believe me it wasn't just the miracle of the resurrection that my professor tried to disprove; he tried to cancel every miracle of the Bible. You see a non-believer cannot have even one miracle of the Bible be true or they have no



foundation to declare their unbelief

It's like the young boy who questioned his science teacher who had declared to the class that no one should believe anything that they haven't seen with their own eves.

Later the teacher was explaining that the cocoon he had kept in an aquarium at the back of the classroom had transformed into a butterfly overnight.

The boy questioned how he could be sure that is what really happened when no one had actually seen it take place.

There are many things that we believe even though we can't see them such as air, gravity, sound waves, wind, radio waves, wifi and Bluetooth signals.

Even though we can't see these things we know they are real because we see their effects all around us.

As a believer, we have not seen the resurrection ourselves, but when we believe the Holy Spirit comes to live in us. We cannot see the Holy Spirit, but we can sure see the effect He has in a person's life. So yes, Jesus was dead.

The second category of evidence is the early accounts we have for the resurrection itself.

In other words, Lee Strobel used to think as an atheist that the resurrection was a legend that took a long time to develop in the ancient world.

What he learned was that we have a preserved creed from the earliest Christian Church that is an evewitness-based report of the resurrection of Jesus.

Now this creed has been

dated back by scholars to within months of the death of Jesus - within months. That is historical gold. This creed gives us a news flash from ancient history on the resurrection.

Thirdly, we have the empty tomb on resurrection morning. The best evidence for the empty tomb is that even the opponents of Jesus implicitly admitted the tomb was empty.

When the disciples began proclaiming that Jesus had risen what the opponent said was, "The disciples stole the body."


They're conceding that the tomb was empty, they're just trying to explain how it got empty. So, everybody's conceding that the tomb was empty.

How it got empty is the real issue, and that goes to the fourth category of evidence, which is the record of the eyewitnesses. For most of what we know about ancient history, it comes from one or maybe two sources of information and yet for the conviction of the disciples that they encountered the resurrected Jesus, we have no fewer than nine ancient sources inside and outside the New Testament confirming and corroborating the conviction of the disciples that they encountered the risen Christ. That is an avalanche of a historical data.

Here's the kicker for me. The resurrection was so real that every one of the disciples except for the betrayer Judas Iscariot and the Apostle John died a martyr's death. Friends, people do not die for a lie.




