It was a very warm and sunny day when my wife and I, along with one of our daughters, her husband and their three kids, hopped in our big conversion van and headed down the highway for a late summer getaway. For years I had wanted to make this trip to Kentucky to investigate a place that I had read and heard much about. It was the highly acclaimed Creation Museum near Cincinnati in Petersburg, Kentucky. Ken Ham is the president/CEO and founder of the ministry called Answers in Genesis that constructed and runs two major ministries. One is the Creation Museum and the second is the Ark Encounter in nearby Williamstown. We were set to take in both places on last weekend's trip.

In fact, he could give a thorough lecture to any high school science class about all the different types of dinosaurs including everything about their habitat, choice of food, size of their brain and every other detail you can think of with no trouble at all.

It took us about seven and a half hours to get there, including a few stops along the way to take care of food and bathroom issues. But when we arrived, we knew we were in for a wonderful time of learning at the museum, Ark, and fun in the hotel swimming pool whenever we could fit that in. I think one of the coolest things about the museum besides the oodles of life-sized dinosaurs was the rooms full of insect collections. Some of them had large claws and others had delicate little antennae. Either way, they were full of the handiwork of God through and through.

We spent an entire day at the museum and after a good night's rest it was off to another of Ken Ham's masterpieces, the Ark Encounter. The Ark Encounter is about 30 minutes from the Creation Museum, and it is just as amazing. This place is a life-sized replica of Noah's Ark in the Bible covering some 450 feet in

length, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet tall. These were the exact dimensions that God gave to Noah when He told him to build this monstrosity. We saw also that every great civilization has similar stories of a universal flood that destroyed the world because of man's wickedness, but a few people and the animals were saved by this huge vessel.

After the flood was over, God put the rainbow in the sky as a reminder that He would never again destroy the world by means of a flood. The Bible does say, however, that God is going to bring judgment upon the earth once again for man's evil. This time it will be for a period of seven years before

Jesus returns to this earth with His bride, the church, who will have been raptured to heaven before these judgments occur. The Bible says that we are to look forward and long for the rapture of the church.

The Apostle Paul writes this in 2 Timothy 4:8, "Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day - and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.'
