alarm for 4 a.m. so I could get up early and head to Kansas City to pick up my daughterin-law and the kids who were coming back from a visit with her parents and family down in Texas. It's amazing how a beef cow can get fat on grass and hay while dairy cows will shrivel up and starve if they don't get some corn.

The drive down to KC was quite enjoyable. The first couple hours in the dark I sang along to some great worship songs. While our temperatures this year still give us a taste of summer, nature knows what's coming. The barn swallows, our annual seasonal avian tourists that fend off the


mosquitoes, have been gone for a couple of weeks. The old dairy barn, their favorite nesting place that echoes with chirping all summer, is quiet.

I heard the call of a whippoorwill.
"Whip-poor-will whip

"Whip-poor-will, whip-poor-will."

The call that conjures

warm summer nights floated across the valley. Whippoorwills also are migratory and spend their winters in Mexico and Central America.
